When UBS decided to consolidate its four Chicago business units, including **UBS PaineWebber** and **UBS Warburg** as well as **LaSalle Partners** into their gleaming new 50 story regional headquarters at 1 North Wacker Drive, they trusted their long time mover, Boyer-Rosene with this 1,500 employee project.
